DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCES FOR BULLYING MT. CARMEL AREA JUNIOR-SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL *Verbal, Physical and/or Cyber*

FIRST OFFENSE

- Verbal reprimand and/or detention
- Parent notification, if warranted
- File an incident report with Bullying Prevention Committee

SECOND OFFENSE

- Detention.
- Parent notification
- File an incident report with Bullying Prevention Committee

THIRD OFFENSE

- Detention
- Possible loss of privileges
- Parent conference
- File an incident report with Bullying Prevention Committee

SERIOUS OFFENSES

- Repeated offenses constitute a defiance of authority and are considered serious infractions of school policy. After three logged bullying incidents, the consequence will be a day of suspension. Future violations will have escalating consequences as outlined in the MCASD Discipline Policy.
- Offenses that are deemed serious infractions as outlined in the MCASD Discipline Policy will result in automatic suspension, regardless of the number of prior offenses.
- File an incident report with Bullying Prevention Committee.

CRIMINAL OFFENSES

- All offenses involving local law enforcement will be disciplined as outlined in the MCADS Discipline Policy. Such criminal offenses may result in a hearing with the MCA Board of Education, expulsion and/or an alternative educational placement.
- File an incident report with Bullying Prevention Committee.

NOTE: When bullying consequences contradict the MCA Discipline Policy, the Discipline Policy shall take precedence.
