**Charter Cyber Costs
July, 2023**

Rising costs

In 2022-2023 our district paid \$935,000 towards cyber education.

The cost of charter school districts continue to grow. Since 2007-08, cyber charter tuition costs have continued to grow by \$1.4 billion, or 229.5% while charter enrollments have only increased by 112.9%

Per student costs to our district for students to attend **OUTSIDE** cyber school

****** Students can attend TELA at a fraction of the cost to our district and taxpayers vs. students attending outside cyber charter schools.***

Regular education student cost to attend OUTSIDE cyber =
Approx **\$8,214**

Special education student cost to attend OUTSIDE cyber =
Approx **\$20,678**

Different Funding Systems

School Districts

Funding is based on the Special Education Funding Formula that differentiates students into three cost tiers according to their level of educational need.

Charter Schools

Funding is based on a “one-size-fits-all” calculation that assumes 16% each school district’s students receive special education services.

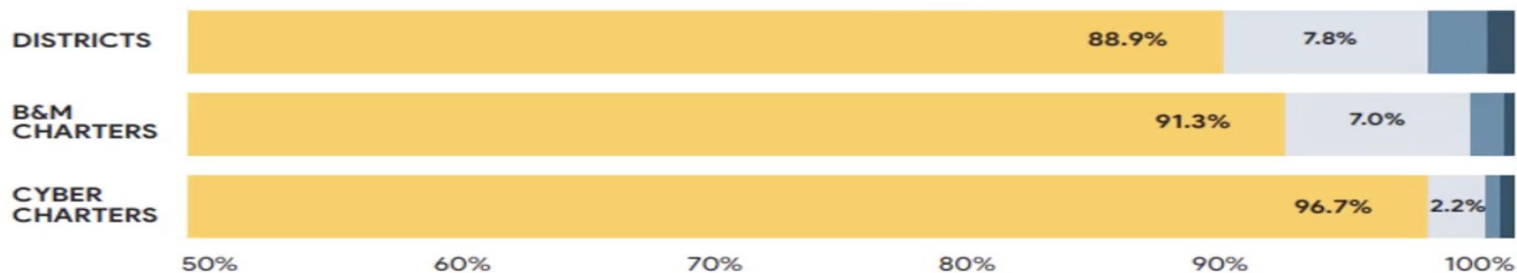
In 2014, the Special Education Funding Commission recommended applying the same formula to charters and districts. Charter schools successfully lobbied to be exempted.

\$185 million in overpayments to charters in 2020-2021

There are far fewer students with high-cost special education needs attending charters than there would be if charters enrolled the same proportion of students in each tier as school districts. Cyber charters enroll very few students with disabilities who require higher-cost services compared to school districts.

MCA CYBER BUDGET NUMBERS

2018-2019: TELA \$104,472 + Outside Cyber (89 students) \$838,522 = **\$942,994**

2019-2020: TELA (45 students) \$109,390 + Outside Cyber (67 students) \$723,313 = **\$833,303**

2020-2021: TELA (30 students) \$50,852 + Outside Cyber (88 students) \$1,126,854 = Current **\$1,177,706**

2021-2022: TELA (63 Full time, 5 Part time students) + Outside Cyber (75 students) = **\$1,168,596.76**

2022-2023: TELA (74 Full time, 7 Part time students) \$201,115 + Outside Cyber (70 students) \$733,870 = **\$934,985**
