Our district created a "Cooperative Education Program" in 2021 that allows seniors to earn credits, during school hours, while getting work experiences in their possible profession of choice after high school graduation.

The summer would be a great opportunity to do some research and have meaningful discussions with our staff and your family about your future plans. *(It is the responsibility of the student to find their possible senior year co-op placement but we are here to help!)*

- How much does the job pay?
- Do I see myself enjoying this career?
- What are the work hours for this occupation?
- What local work opportunities exist in our immediate area?
