

This is a message for students and parents of the Mount Carmel Area School District.

In an effort to continue with our district safety initiatives — **starting on Wednesday, November 29th**, students in grades 7 to 12 will be expected to produce their assigned student ID for bus entry every morning and afternoon. It is the student responsibility to wear the ID and lanyard that will be provided by the school district to the student, at no cost. Student ID and lanyard will be given to all students that ride bus transportation by Tuesday, November 28th. (*Elementary students will receive IDs later in the school year.*)

More information:

- Every morning and afternoon the bus driver will check for a student ID to allow entry on the bus. The student should simply enter the bus and show their ID to the bus driver.
- Students may only ride their assigned bus.
- **If a student has a lost ID**, the driver will check their name to verify that they are in fact on that bus roster, then allow entry.
- The bus driver will not deny student entry without speaking to a school district administrator.
